

We are a 13 bed Cardiothoracic Step-down Unit (CTSU) that specializes in the care of post-surgical cardiac, thoracic and vascular patients. The nurse to patient ration is 1:3.

Using a multi-disciplinary approach we care for patients that have undergone CABG, heart valve repair/ replacement, VAD placement, heart/lung transplant, aortic/thoracic aneurysm repair, and vascular surgeries.

Cardiac Surgery

CTSU nursing staff care for patients who have undergone various types of surgical intervention for heart related conditions. These range from coronary artery bypass graft (CABG), ventricular assist device (VAD) placement, and heart transplant. This also includes less invasive procedures such as ablation, and transthoracic aortic valve replacement (TAVR).





Thoracic surgery patients have often undergone wedge resections, lobectomy and pneumonectomy via video assisted thoracotomy (VATS) or open thoracotomy. We also care for patients that are post-transplant, and postesophageal repair. Our nursing care is instrumental in patient outcomes. Aggressive pulmonary hygiene allows thoracic surgery patients to experience less morbidities and discharge as expected or earlier.

Vascular patients range from those receiving thrombolytic therapy for deep vein thrombosis, limb amputation, carotid endarterectomy, and vascular bypasses. Close neurovascular monitoring contributes to patients' successful recovery.
